# 1. Perspective

To The Citizens of Cuyahoga County,

Since 1902, Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court has continued the dedication and commitment of its founders who sought to establish a separate court for juveniles. They recognized that a child who breaks the law should be dealt with by the state not as a criminal, but as a child needing care, education, and protection. These goals are as pertinent in 1986 as they were in 1902; to these goals we address the staff, the programs and the efforts of the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court.

As Administrative Judge, I have worked closely with the Court Administrator, Allyn R. Sielaff, and a support staff of 500 to maintain quality services to Cuyahoga County and to respond to the constantly changing needs of the community and those individuals who come to the attention of the court. In the past year, our five judges and ten referees have heard and disposed of over 30,000 cases involving the youth of this area. We have responded to matters of the delinquent, the dependent, the neglected, the abused and the unruly as well as cases of child support, parent/child relationships, and juvenile traffic offenses.

This year signalled some changes in the court. In November, 1986, Timothy G. Cotner was elected to a new jurist position within the Juvenile Court. On an administrative level, three departments, Administration, Community Services, and Operations, have been restructured to promote a more efficient use of both personnel and funds.

One of the most notable achievements of 1986 has been the implementation of the A.C.T. (Assess, Classify, Treat) System. Designed to concentrate on the supervision and rehabilitation of the chronic offenders who commit a disproportionately large number of juvenile crimes, this system shifts a significant portion of the Juvenile Court's resources to provide services to the chronic juvenile offender population. A four member Intensive Probation Unit consists of a team leader, a probation counselor, and two surveillance workers whose efforts provide daily contact with probation personnel, weekly counseling for both the offender and his/her family, and referral to appropriate community resources. Each of the six Intensive Probation Unit teams can handle up to 30 youth who have been statistically assessed as most likely to become chronic offenders.

Within its legal authority, Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court provides the proper care and control necessary to promote individual growth and development of troubled youth. In its 84-year history, the court has demonstrated the ability to evaluate and treat the many-faceted problems of juveniles. Our tradition dictates that we continue to meet the challenges of youth in the Eighties.

# 3. Statistics

## Ten-Year Trend Downward for Official Delinquency Cases

In the five-year period, 1977 through 1981, a total of 29,419 official delinquency cases were filed in the Juvenile Court of Cuyahoga County. In the five-year period, 1982 through 1986, a total of 25,174 such cases were filed, resulting in a decrease of 14%, or 4,245 less cases filed in the latter period.

Paralleling the decrease in total official delinquency filings between the two five-year periods was a 12% decline in the serious offenses of homicide, assault, robbery, use of weapons and arson. In the five-year period, 1977 through 1981, these offenses amounted to a combined total of 8,736, whereas in the five-year period, 1982 through 1986, they amounted to 7,672, or 1,064 less cases filed in the latter period. The table below lists the above offenses as well as the total official delinquency cases for the two five-year periods.

Reflecting the decrease in official delinquency cases for the ten-year period were the declines in commitments to state correctional institutions and in the number of children bound-over to the Criminal Division of the Court of Common Pleas to be tried as adults.

For the five-year period, 1977 through 1981, the Court committed 3,232 children to the Ohio Department of Youth Services. In the five-year period, 1982 through 1986, a total of 2,293 children were committed. This represents a decrease of 29% in commitments to the Youth Commission, or 939 less children in the latter five-year period. Bind-overs to the Criminal Division of the Court in the latter period were nearly one-half of what they were in the first five-year period. From 1977 through 1981, there were 269 bind-overs compared with 140 in the period, 1982 through 1986. This represents a decline of 48%, or 129 less children bound-over as adults.
