JUVENILE COURT HOME DETENTION ORDER

RULES OF SUPERVISION

You have been placed by the Court under the Supervision of the Home Detention Unit of the Juvenile Court. This means that the Court believes you can be a responsible citizen pending your scheduled Court Hearing or Placement, with the help and support of your parents and the Home Detention Officer.

HOME DETENTION ORDER

I, _____, will obey the rules of this Home Detention Order that are checked on the following pages. I further agree to obey the laws of the community, keep appointments on time and cooperate with my parent(s), legal guardian(s) and Home Detention Officer as part of this order. I understand that breaking any of these rules could cause me to return to the Juvenile Detention Center.

This Home Detention Order goes into effect **immediately** upon your leaving the Detention Center and will be in effect until you appear at your next court hearing or if a Violation of Court Order is filed.

JUVENILE'S RESPONSIBILITY:

ACCOUNTABILITY

- 1. When I am not attending school/work or appointments authorized by my Home Detention Officer, I will remain inside my home at all times, the porch, garage or driveway is not allowed.
- 2. I understand that my parent/guardian must notify the Home Detention Officer at least twenty-four hours in advance to authorize appointments outside the home, (i.e., counseling sessions, doctor/dentist appointment, parole officer or probation officer scheduled appointments and/or legal meetings).
- 3. I understand that in order to attend/participate *in* religious services, my parent/guardian must notify my Home Detention Officer no later than 24 hrs. prior to weekday services, and no later than Thursday for weekend services and I must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 4. I will be available for all contacts, visitations, and/or phone calls by a Home Detention Officer at all times. I will be in violation of the program, if/when Home Detention Staff are unable to verify my whereabouts for any reason.
- 5. I understand that I am not permitted to have guests in the home without parental supervision and permission at all times.

SCHOOL

- 1. My school hours are _____ to _____. I will leave my residence **only** during school hours, from _____ to _____ and come directly home after school.
- 2. I will attend school daily and all my classes regularly. My parent/guardian will notify my Home Detention Officer no later than 10:00 a.m. if I am unable to attend.
- 3. I will have school slips signed daily by teachers and turn them in to the Home Detention Officer on a daily basis. I will obey all school rules and regulations.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. I will leave my residence during work hours and come directly home after work. My work schedule is to be given to the Home Detention Officer on a weekly basis.
- 2. I will not drive or ride in a car or other motorized vehicle unless driven by my parent/guardian.
- 3. I will not associate with my co-defendants while on Home Detention, as identified below;

ELECTRONIC MONITORING CONDITIONS (if applicable)

- 1. I understand that my parent/guardian and I must report for Electronic Monitoring hook up and installation on _____ Date _____ Time.
- 2. I understand that the converter box is to be hooked up **immediately** in my place of residence and **must remain connected at all times.**
- 3. I understand that the Electronic Monitoring transmitter will be worn on my ankle until removed by a Juvenile Court Official.
- 4. I understand that the E.M. equipment must be returned to the Home Detention Intake Office **immediately upon completion of the Program.**
- 5. I will immediately report any equipment malfunctions to the Home Detention Officer.

VIOLATING ANY CONDITIONS OF THE HOME DETENTION CONTRACT WILL BE ADDRESSED BY THE HOME DETENTION OFFICER WHICH MAY RESULT IN A REQUEST FOR WARRANT, DETAINMENT IN THE DETENTION CENTER PENDING A RULE 7 HEARING.

HOME DETENTION OFFICER'S CALLING POLICY

- I understand that my Home Detention Officer is to be called **when necessary** from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays, (i.e., when I do not go to school/work or to attend unscheduled or emergency appointments). **The Home Detention Office can be reached at 216-443-3330 after 4:30 p.m. on weekdays, weekends and holidays.**

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- I will notify the Home Detention Officer when my child violates conditions of the Program, (i.e., runaway, unauthorized leave, school suspension, and subsequent arrest).
- I understand that if my child behaves in an aggressive or unsafe manner to him/herself or others, I will notify the police immediately, and call the Home Detention Officer.
- I will discuss any scheduled appointments for my child with the Home Detention Officer on a timely basis.
- I will notify the Home Detention Officer when my child does not attend school or work no later than 10:00 a.m.
- I will inform the Home Detention Officer of hours of worship on a weekly basis, no later than Thursday p.m.
- I will attend mandatory Home Detention violation meetings with my child when necessary.
- I will notify the Home Detention Officer of any change of address, telephone number or disconnection of telephone service, immediately.
- I will be present with my child for scheduled electronic monitoring appointments.
