

## Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court Juvenile Division Text Message Reminder Program

Court Text Message Program: The Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court and its Internal Departments (e.g. Probation Dept., Diagnostic Clinic) now have the ability to send text-message reminders when hearings and certain appointments are scheduled pertaining to your case. These reminders will be in addition to the hearing notices sent by the Court to parties by regular mail. For those who opt in and have an eligible cell phone provider, text message reminders will be sent to your cell phone number from <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jupen.com/216-332-3675">216-332-3675</a>.

MESSAGE AND DATA RATES MAY APPLY.

Frequency of texts: Typically, for each scheduled event or hearing, you will receive a text message reminder 7 days and 1 day before your scheduled event or hearing. Additional manual messages pertaining to your case(s) or court business may also be sent from time-to-time. You may receive multiple messages per month for text alerts depending on the activity of your case(s).

I understand that text-messaging rates through my cell phone provider may apply to any messages received from Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court. I agree not to hold Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court liable for any electronic messaging charges or fees generated by this service.

I understand that in the event my cell phone number changes, I will need to complete and submit a new authorization form and file it with the Clerk's Office.
